

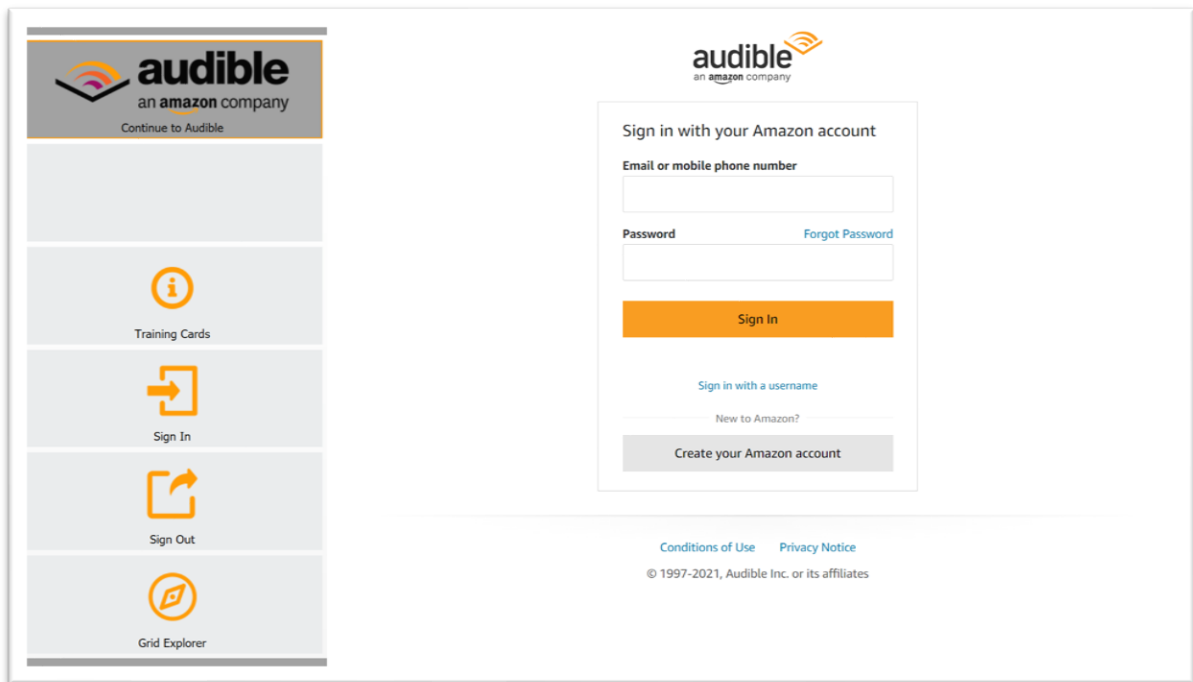

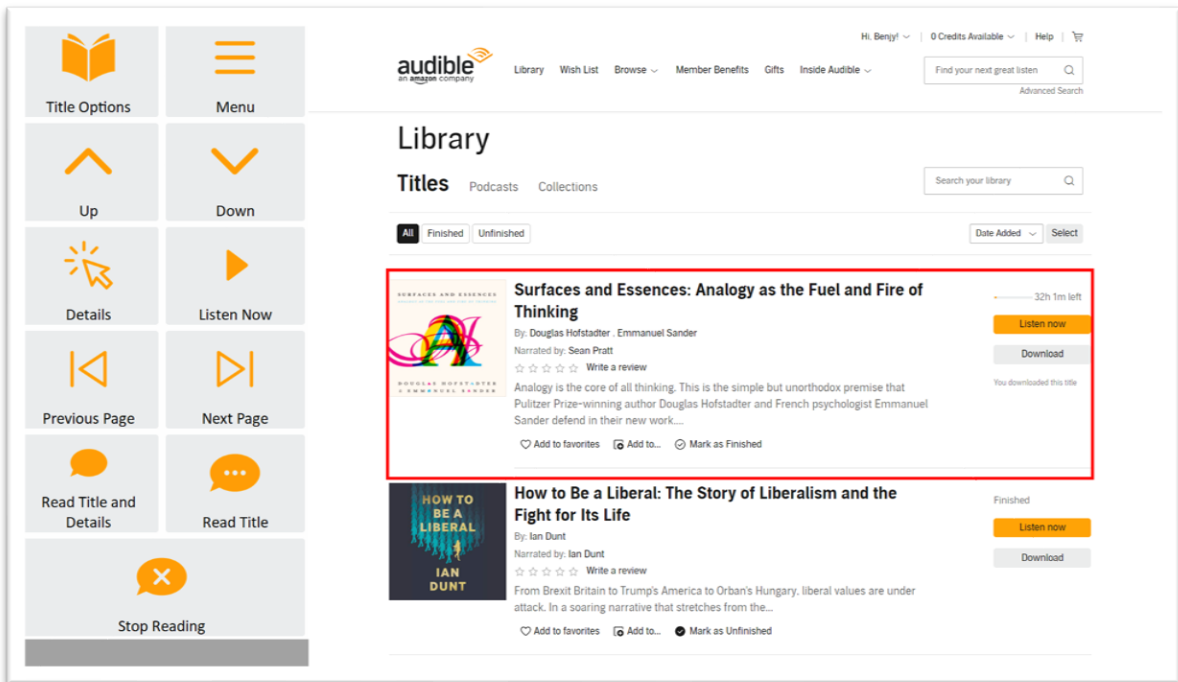
Getting Started

- **Requirements** – to use Accessible Audible you need to have an Audible account. Make sure to have your login and password available.
- **Login** – After selecting the **Join-In Audible** Gridset from your Grid Explorer, follow the sequence – **Login and Info** => **Sign In** => **Email or Phone** => enter your Audible (Amazon) account email or phone number => **Password** => enter your Audible (Amazon) account password => **Sign In**.
- You are now logged in to your Audible account. Select **Continue to Audible** to start using the app.
- Join-In Gridsets are available in different languages and optimized for use with different input devices. For most apps there is also a regular 'Full' version and a 'Lite' version with larger buttons and almost identical functionality. Please refer to the Join-In for Grid 3 [Getting Started](#) guide for information on how to download the Gridsets that are best for you.

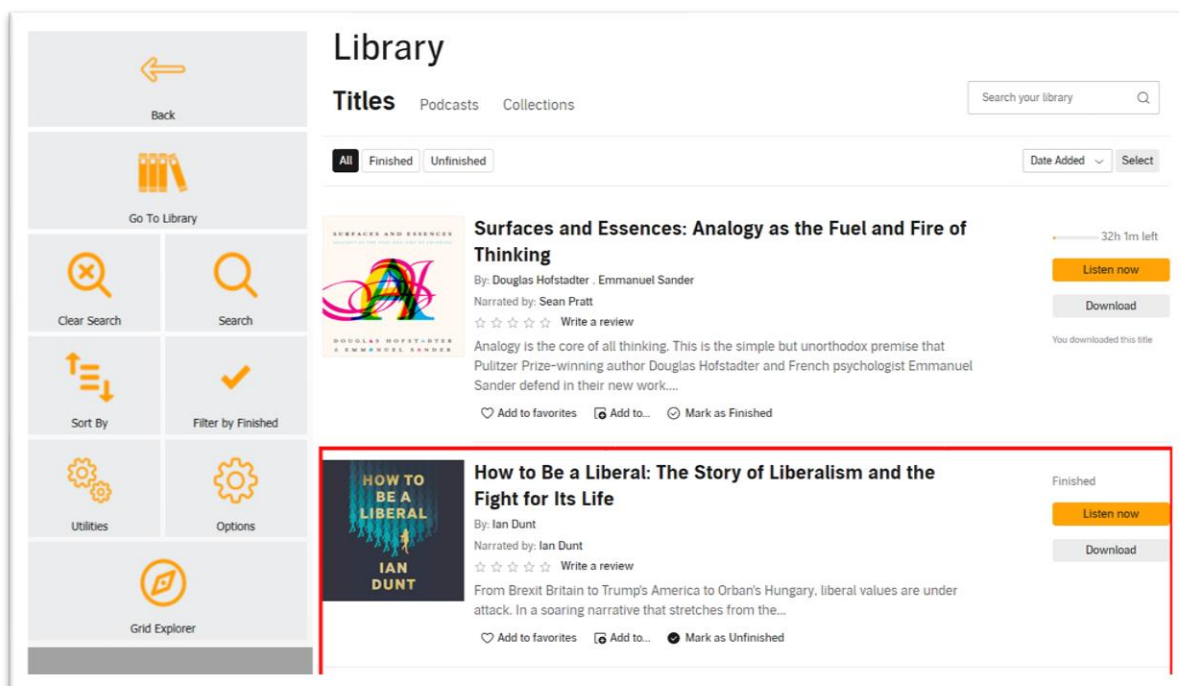
Where Am I?

- When you launch Audible and the site finishes loading you will arrive at either your Audible Library page or the Audible Player page – depending on which location you closed from the last time you used the site.
- To access the right controls for this part of the site you need you click **Go To Audible Library** or **Go To Audible Player**.
- If you are not sure where you are, click **Where Am I?** to get a notification telling you which button to click.



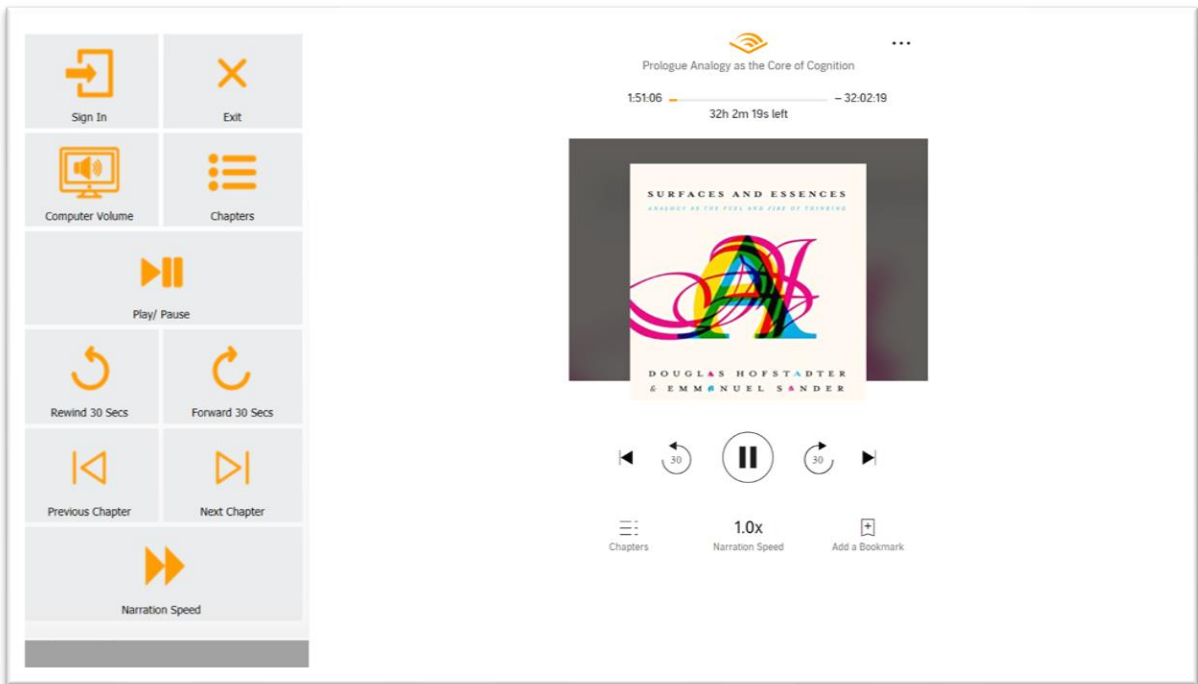
Home

- **Up** and **Down** arrows – a red border frame highlights the currently selected audio book or journal in your library. Use the arrows to navigate up and down your list.
- **Title Options** – allows you to mark an item as finished, rate it and write a review.
- **Menu** – go to the Join-In Audible Menu.
- **Details** – open and show the details of the selected item. If this selected item is a book, it will allow you to review the book details and to play it. If it is a journal, it will allow you to browse episodes and select one to play.
- **Listen Now** – play the selected item and go to the Audible Player Page.
- **Previous Page** and **Next Page** – go to the next or previous page in your library.
- **Read Title and Details** – read aloud the title and description of the selected item.
- **Read Title** – read aloud the title of the selected item.
- **Stop Reading** – stop reading aloud.



Menu

- **Go To Library** – return to library view if you are in a different part of the site.
- **Search** – search for an item in your library.
- **Clear Search** – clear the search results and go back to your library.
- **Sort by** – sort items in your library by title, author, length or date added to your library.
- **Filter by Finished** – select if you want to filter your items by All/Finished/Unfinished.
- **Utilities** – recover/reopen Audible, , **Block Touch** or **Allow Touch** access, close windows you do not need, close pop-up messages, zoom in or zoom out, etc.
- **Options** – change the computer volume level, toggle text enlargement and adjust text size, toggle auto-read on or off, Log In or Log Out of your Audible account, and open the [Join-In Settings](#) app.
- **Grid Explorer** – Exit Join-In Audible.



Player Page

- **Sign In** – After you select a title to listen to, Audible may require that you sign-in again. Use this button to sign in to your Audible account.
- **Exit** – choose one of three options when you leave the player page;
 1. Stop listening and return to your library.
 2. Exit Audible but continue listening in the background.
 3. Stop listening and close Audible.
- **Computer Volume** – increase or decrease the computer volume.
- **Chapters** – go to the list of chapters and select one to play.
- **Play / Pause** – play or pause the current item.
- **Rewind 30 Secs** – jump 30 seconds backward.
- **Forward 30 Secs** – jump 30 seconds forward.
- **Previous** and **Next Chapter** – move to the previous or next chapters.
- **Narration Speed** – change the narration speed.
