## **Getting Started**

- <u>Requirements</u> there are no special requirements to use MSN.
- <u>Language and Region selection</u> MSN selects app language and content automatically. You can change the language and region at any time.
- <u>To change the selections the first time you use MSN</u> click *Accessible MSN* from your Home Page, click *Info* => *Change MSN Language*. A table of the available languages will appear. After selecting a language, you will be able to select a country.
- You are now ready to use MSN. Select *Continue to MSN* to start using the app





#### **Home Page**

- Scroll Through Ads / Skip Ads toggle between scrolling through and skipping ads. Button caption changes accordingly.
- *Menu* go to MSN menu.
- Select Category filter the articles shown to you by the categories offered by MSN (see <u>Page 7</u>).
- **Up, Down, Previous** and **Next** arrows a red border frame is always shown around one of the articles to show which one is currently selected. Use the arrows to move the frame (skipping ads if **Skip Ads** is on).
- **Open Article** open the selected article. Buttons on the opened page depends on the content of the article (video, pictures gallery, "regular" article...)
- *Read Title* read the title of the selected article aloud.
- Slider left and Slider right These buttons appear only if the selected item has a "slider" – usually the top left item on the page. Allows you to browse the content of the slider, while skipping ads.





#### Menu

- *First* **Article** takes you to the top left article on the page.
- Last Article takes you to the last article on the page (the last article in the browser cash).
- Change MSN Language change MSN language and region settings.
- **Utilities** recover / reopen MSN, **Block Touch** or **Allow Touch** access, close windows you do not need, close pop-up messages, zoom in or zoom out,...
- Options change the computer volume, turn <u>auto-read of titles</u> on and off, turn <u>auto-read of articles</u> on or off, toggle text enlargement, go to additional advanced MSN options (text enlargement factor, max words for auto-read), and access the <u>Join-In Settings</u> app..
- Exit (Communicator Home Page) exit Accessible MSN







## **Regular Article**

- The buttons you see on an article viewing page depend on the type of article you have opened. The image above shows a regular article.
- Exit Article back to MSN home page..
- *Reading Enabled* change the behavior of the page and reveal buttons to use in *Read* mode.
- *Up / Down* scroll up and down the page.
- Video / Gallery if a red border frame appears around a media item at you scroll through the article, you can use these buttons to access buttons for interacting with it.
- Options access and adjust a selection of useful settings without needing to go back to the menu and options page. You can change Computer Volume, Auto-Read preferences and toggle Text Enlargement here.
- *More For You* when you see the *More For You* section of suggested articles at the bottom of the page, you can click here to access them.







## **Video Article**

- *Exit Video* back to MSN home page or the article holding the video.
- Volume Controls go to a page with volume controls.
- Play / Pause start or stop the video.
- Full Screen view at full size with Join-In Full Screen Video Player.
- Up Next play next video in the Up Next panel on the right of the screen.
- **Forward and Back** jump forward and back within the video you are watching, including with **Bookmarks** to get to specific points.
- *Read Text / Stop Reading* hear the text below the video read aloud.
- Options access and adjust a selection of useful settings without needing to go back to the menu and options page. You can change Computer Volume, Auto-Read preferences and toggle Text Enlargement here.
- More For You when you see the More For You section of suggested articles at the bottom of the page, you can click here to access them.





## **Select Category**

- Clicking Select Contacts on the MSN home page opens a popup table of categories to filter the articles that are shown to you. You will be redirected to a menu toolbar to help you choose one based on your accessibility settings.
- The buttons you see depend on the <u>Selection Method</u> applied in the <u>Join-In</u> <u>Settings</u> app. Consult these training cards for full guidance on how to change your accessibility settings.
