

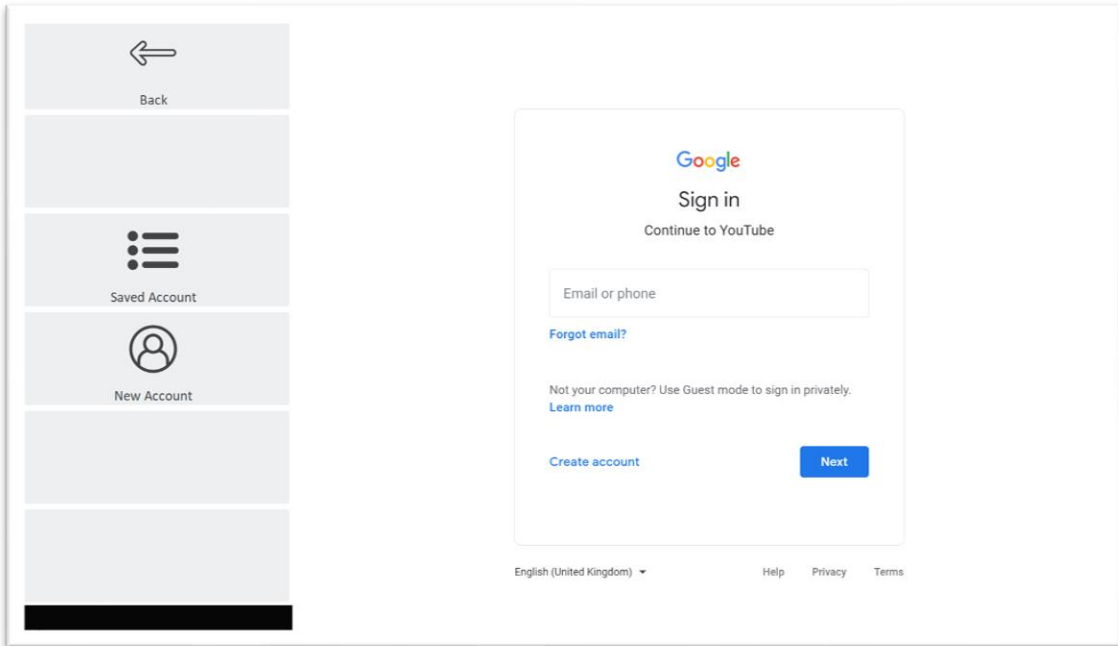

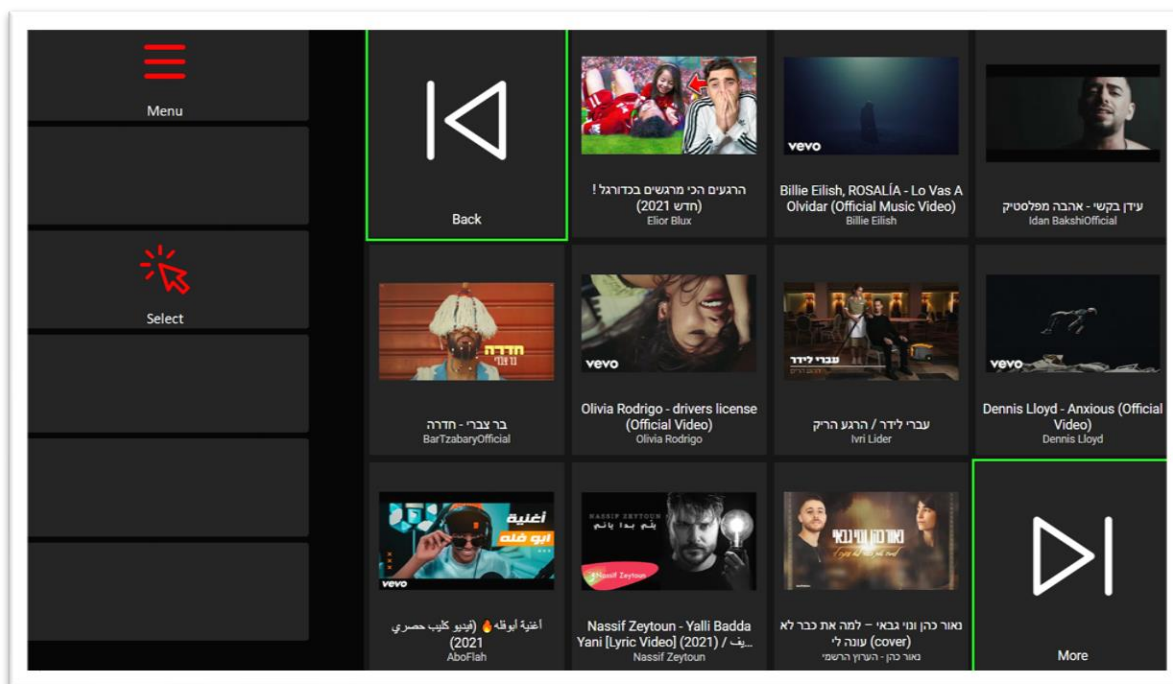

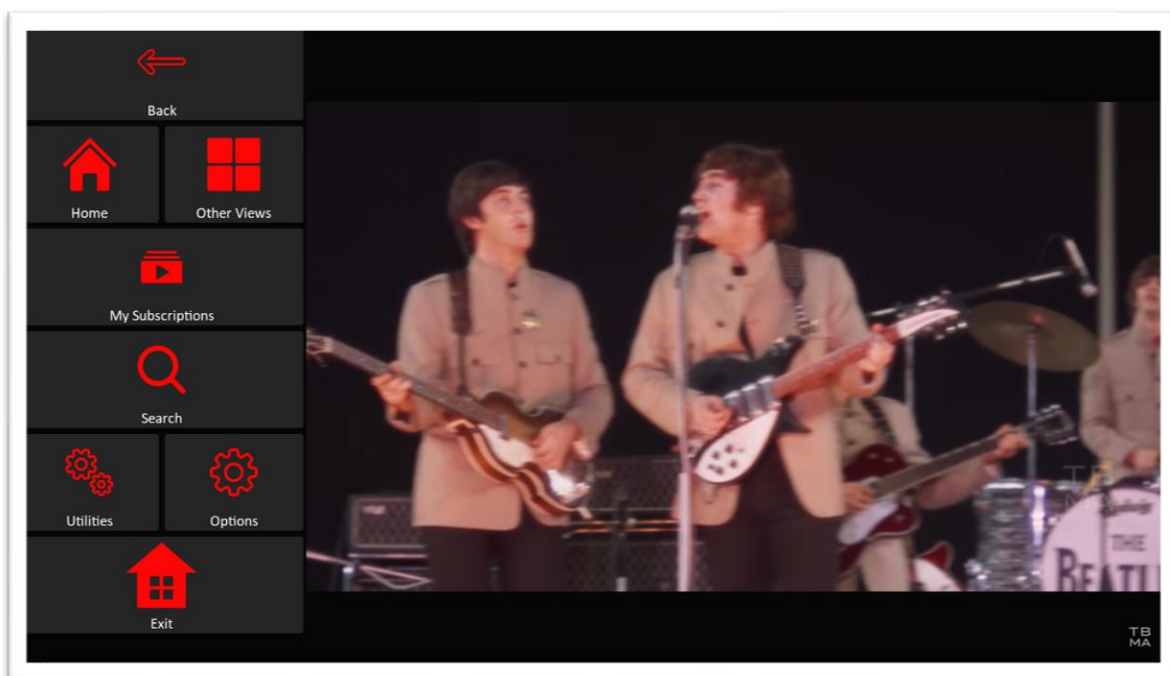
Getting Started

- You do not need to have an account to use YouTube, but more features are available if you are logged in. You can log in to Accessible YouTube with a Google account.
- **Login** – after selecting **Accessible Youtube** from your Communicator 5 Home page, follow the sequence – **Login and Info** => **Sign In** => **Email or Phone** => enter your Google account email or phone number => **Next** => **Password** => enter your Google account password => **Next** => **Sign In**.
- You are now logged in to your Google account. Click **Continue to YouTube** to start using the app.



Home

- The Home page and most other pages on the YouTube website are made up of many rows of videos to choose from and watch. Accessible YouTube presents these videos in a popup table for ease of navigation and selection.
- The way that the Communicator 5 toolbar and the popup table look and work together depend on the accessibility preferences you have chosen.
- The [Selection Method](#) you have applied in the [Join-In Settings](#) app determines which buttons you will see on the toolbar.
- The table size you have chosen within Accessible YouTube [Additional Options](#) determines how many videos you will see at a time and how large they appear on the screen.
- **Back** and **More** arrows – these arrows are highlighted and enabled for **Direct Selection** at all times. Clicking these arrows will take you to the previous or next page of videos.
- **Menu** – takes you to the main menu for Accessible YouTube.



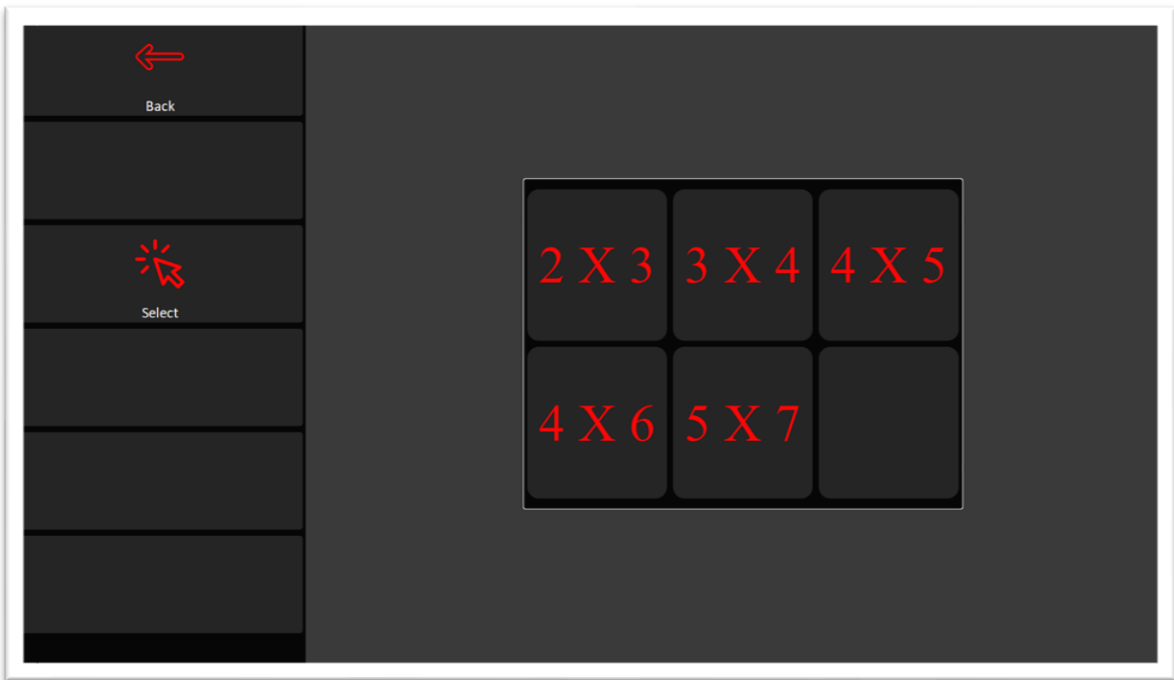
Menu

- **Back** – return to the video you were watching or the list of videos you were looking at.
- **Home** – go to YouTube Home page.
- **Other Views** – see a variety of different collections of videos; your viewing **History**, your **Subscriptions Feed**, your **Watch Later** list, your **Liked Videos** and **Trending**. Most are only available if you are logged in.
- **My Subscriptions** – see the channels you’re subscribed to and visit one.
- **Search** – click to search for videos.
- **Utilities** – **Recover** or reopen YouTube, **Block Touch** or **Allow Touch** access, close windows you do not need, close popup messages, zoom in or zoom out...
- **Options** – change the computer volume, set ads to skip automatically (when YouTube allows), access the [Join-In Settings](#) app, or use **Additional Options** to edit the way Accessible YouTube shows you collections of videos (see [Page 7](#)).
- **Exit** (Communicator Home Page) – exit Accessible YouTube.



Video Player

- **Menu** – go to YouTube Menu.
- **Back** – go to previous video or reopen the table you first selected a video from.
- **Play / Pause** – play or pause the current video.
- **Forward and Rewind** – go to a page allowing you to jump forward or backward in the video being played.
- **Player Volume** – go to a page with video volume controls.
- **Full Screen** – view your video at full size with Join-In [Full Screen Video Player](#).
- **Skip Ad** – close pop-up windows and skip ads (only where YouTube allows it).
- **More** – **Like** or **Dislike** the video, **Subscribe** or **Unsubscribe** to the current channel, add you your **Watch Later** list, **View Channel** to see more from the same creator.
- **Video Options** – toggle subtitles, toggle auto-play next video (at the end of a video).
- **Playlist** – if the video you are watching is part of a **Playlist**, you can click this button to see a table of the other videos in the playlist. The current video will continue to play in the background.
- **Related Videos** – present related videos (determined by YouTube) in a table. The current video will continue to play in the background.



Additional Options

- This page is accessible from the **Options** page – change the dimensions of the videos table. These dimensions are used for **Home, Search Results, History, Subscriptions Feed, Watch Later, Liked Videos, Trending, Related Videos** and **Playlists**.
- The [Selection Method](#) you have applied in the [Join-In Settings](#) app determines which buttons you will see on the toolbar.
